



COUNCIL CONTINUES TO HOLD THE LINE ON TAXES



Horsham Township Council has held the line on taxes once again. Horsham residents will see no change to the municipal tax rate in the adopted 2013 budget. The Township real estate tax will remain at one mill for the tenth consecutive year. Horsham has the lowest tax rate in Eastern Montgomery County and has the sixth lowest rate out of the 62 municipalities in Montgomery County.

The one mill real estate tax equals \$1 for every \$1,000 of assessed value on a property. The owner of a home assessed at the township average of \$178,371 will pay \$178.37, of that \$83.83 will be for the Library, \$55.30 will be for the Fire Company and \$39.24 will go towards Parks and Recreation. None of the real estate tax revenue will go for the administration of the local government.

The Township's 2013 budget is set at \$14.2 million. It includes road milling and paving in the Oak Hill development; a storm sewer project in the Horsham Terrace development; a new playground, picnic pavilion and restrooms in Kohler Park; a creek bank stabilization project in Clearbrook Park; repairs to the Carpenter Park tennis courts; a comprehensive website renovation.; replacing old streetlights with new, energy efficient lights and a Route 611 Corridor Revitalization Plan.

Horsham Township Evaluating Energy Use In Municipal Operations

Horsham Township has been selected to receive Direct Technical Assistance under the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission's (DVRPC) Circuit Rider Program for Energy Efficiency in Local Government. DVRPC received a Climate Showcase Communities Grant from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency to fund this program. The Township is one of only ten (10) communities selected from Bucks, Chester, Delaware and Montgomery Counties.

This program will offer no-cost assistance from DVRPC and an independent Energy Expert in the evaluation of energy use among municipal operations and identify measures to reduce energy costs. Horsham has established a commitment to reducing energy costs by installing motion-sensor light switches and LED traffic lights. The Township is proud to partner with DVRPC to ensure further sustainability and cost saving measures.



Love Your Creeks Don't Salt Them

Using less salt on your sidewalk and driveway this winter shows your love for the creeks and streams in Horsham Township.

If you must use a deicer, use it sparingly and make sure you read the label or application rates and environmental effects.

Don't use salt when you can use a shovel.




Winter Snow Removal

The following are a few things that you can do to help ensure a safe and happy winter for yourself and Horsham Township:

- ❄ Once snow accumulates two (2) inches or more and until the roadway is cleared by the Highway Department, no vehicle, trailer, boat or camper may be parked in the roadway. Violating this regulation could result in a fine.
- ❄ Keeping sidewalks safe is an important winter concern. Residents must clear snow, sleet and ice from sidewalks in front of their property no more than 24 hours after a storm. For stubborn icy spots, be sure to use ice control methods. Sidewalks should be swept free of salt remains after snow melts to prevent deterioration of the concrete.
- ❄ Trash cans and recycling containers may not be placed on the street. This inhibits the snow plows from doing their job. Please place your trash cans and recycling containers on the lawn or curb in front of your property.
- ❄ Remember that it is illegal to shovel, blow or plow the snow from your driveway and/or sidewalk into the street.
- ❄ Be sure that your mail box is properly and securely installed to avoid damage from flying snow from snow plows. It is the Township's policy not to replace mailboxes that are damaged during the normal course of clearing a road. Only mail boxes that are hit directly by the snow plow will be considered for reimbursement. Reimbursement is limited to the cost of a standard mailbox.
- ❄ Keep the storm water inlet open near your property. Keeping it open will prevent flooding and icing conditions on the street.

The Highway Department works extremely hard to make traveling on Township roads safe for everyone. In the event of a storm, snow will be plowed first on the main streets, next on secondary streets and finally on cul-de-sac and dead-end streets. Please be patient and allow ample time for them to arrive in your area.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

Permits: When the snow starts to thaw, residents start thinking about Spring projects that they would like to start on their property. The Code Enforcement office would like to remind you that permits are required for any zoning work such as fences, sheds, paving, etc. Building permits are required for any alterations, additions, finished basements, decks, swimming pools, etc. If in doubt, call the Code Enforcement Department at (215) 643-3131.

All Parks and Recreation programs are open to residents and non-residents. All programs will require the completion of a medical release and liability waiver. All programs have a minimum and maximum participation requirement, so please register early. Programs are subject to cancellation due to insufficient registrations, inclement weather or any other reasonable cause. NO REFUNDS will be given unless you provide us with a medical note stating why you cannot participate in the program or if we receive at least 48 hours notice prior to the starting date of the program, as long as your cancellation does not reduce the participation level below the required minimum. There will be a \$10 fee charged for any withdrawal. If your withdrawal impacts the ability of the class to run, you will not be refunded. No refunds will be given for bus trips. If a class is canceled or closed, you will receive a full refund in the form of a check. There is a \$25 charge for any check returned by the bank. Real Estate Tax Bills

Real Estate Tax bills for Horsham Township and Montgomery County will be mailed by February 1, 2013. The tax bill provides a portion of the necessary income for the Township to run effectively. Payment is due as follows:

April 30, 2013 - due at 2% discount

June 30, 2013 - due at face amount

Tax payments made after June 30th are paid at a 10% penalty. Postmarks within the stated deadlines are accepted; and deadlines that fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, are due

on the next business day. The deadline for the payment of real estate taxes to Horsham Township is by 12:00 noon on December 31st, and failure to pay by that deadline results in a lien being placed on the property and collection through the Montgomery County Tax Claim Bureau.

Any request for a change in mailing address must be submitted to Horsham Township in writing. The Township does not change the property owner's name unless directed by the County.





Calling 9-1-1 From A Cell Phone

The Montgomery County Department of Public Safety asks that anyone who calls 9-1-1 from a cellular phone in communities near the County border immediately state that *"I'm calling from Montgomery County"* when the call-taker answers the phone.

If the nearest cell tower to where the call is placed is across the border in a neighboring county, the call will be routed to the 9-1-1 centers in Philadelphia, Bucks, Berks, Chester or Delaware counties, depending on where the tower is located. Stating *"I'm calling from Montgomery County"* at the outset will greatly reduce any delay in getting people the help they need.



Using a landline to call 9-1-1 will result in the call automatically being routed to the proper call center.

CODE - Spring Safety Tips



• **Smoke detector batteries should be checked,** and replaced if necessary and units should be cleared of dust.

• **Never burn yard waste or trash.** It is illegal and very dangerous.

• **Windows should be checked** to make sure they open and close properly, in case they are needed as exits.

• **Review your family's Fire Escape Plan.**



• **Help emergency services find you!** Post your street address. If it is posted already, make sure it is visible from the street (minimum 4 inches in height and contrast with their background). Painted numbers on the curb do not comply with this requirement.

• **Electric outlets and extension cords should not be overloaded.** Electric wiring should be checked for damage, and replaced if necessary.



HLRA Update

The newly formed Horsham Land Redevelopment Authority (HLRA) is taking steps to implement the Redevelopment Plan for the former Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base Willow Grove. The new HLRA, established by Horsham Township Council in June 2012, will work to acquire the former Navy property through an Economic Development Conveyance (EDC). The Navy is currently



preparing a mandated Environmental Impact Statement which will review the environmental impacts of the redevelopment of the base. The Horsham Township Authority for NAS-JRB, which created the Redevelopment Plan, voted to dissolve itself in September 2012 (as it had fulfilled its mission). 


