Big Changes Coming to Kohler Park



Township Council (above) is excited to announce, through strategic planning and cooperative efforts, multiple enhancements to Kohler Park. Located between Horsham Road and Limekiln Pike, Kohler Park is the oldest and one of the most frequently visited parks in the Township's Park System. Kohler Park is home to a 2.1 acre fishing pond, gazebo, picnic grove, soccer fields, clubhouse/concession stand, In-Line Skate Park, Dog Park and interior paved trail network with pedestrian bridge.

In 2009, the Horsham Township Council recognized the need to develop a Master Site Plan to address several longstanding issues in the park. Council secured a PA-DCNR grant to assist in funding the planning process. The Master Site Plan, finalized in 2010 identified multiple items to be addressed at a substantial cost and over 10 years to complete.

"Best Places to Live in America" by CNN Money Magazine!



Why is Horsham Township continually recognized? We have beautiful parks, a township-wide trail system, modern retail centers featuring high-quality restaurants, the Blue Ribbon recognized Hatboro-Horsham School District, wonderful neighborhoods and homes to satisfy any budget, many active local civic organizations that make great contributions to the community, and high-end office parks with companies that give back to the community with their active promotion of public service among their employees.

Township Council has worked diligently with staff to keep our spending down and services steady. They continue to make decisions which improve the quality of life for all while maintaining our Township’s character. Our extensive park system has grown from 250 acres in 1989 to over 850 acres in 2013 and offers a wide array of parks. We have one of the best township-wide trail networks featuring the Powerline Trail as the main stem. The Township has not raised taxes in ten years and has the lowest tax rate in Eastern Montgomery County and the 6th lowest out of 62 municipalities in Montgomery County. We have a state of the art library which saw 128,495 visitors in 2012.


In order to continuously improve Horsham’s high quality of life, we have built two firehouses, a community center, a public works facility, and a new police station and also widened Horsham Road and Dresher Road—all without increasing taxes. 




LED Streetlight

Retrofit Program Begins

Horsham Township has begun phase one of converting the incandescent street lights with LED lights. Phase one includes 64 lights which will be installed by the end of the year. The lights will be installed in the area from County Line Road to Moreland Road and Meetinghouse Road to Blair Mill Road. The new LED lights will reduce the carbon footprint by 17.02 metric tons, save 27,715.69 kw/h in energy each year and have a cost savings of \$2,200.00 each year. We are targeting old streetlights which have become obsolete.

The Township is committed to saving energy and reducing costs. We have already converted our traffic lights to LED's and we have been working with the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission on ways to further reduce energy at our facilities.



Coming Soon....Trail to Continue through Horsham Estates from Babylon Road to Limekiln Pike

For those residents that love to walk, run and bike on the Powerline Trail, the next phase is in the works for completion late Fall of this year. The bridge has been delivered and work has begun to carve out what will be the newest edition to the trail system that has become an important part of what makes Horsham Township such an enjoyable place to live, work and raise a family.

This important piece of the network links Babylon Road to Limekiln Pike. The 12-foot wide paved trail begins at Babylon Road and runs 0.75 miles along the perimeter of the Horsham Valley Estates Development to the Township open space at Kohler Park Soccer Field parking lot. From there, the trail crosses over Limekiln Pike and continues on the 1.12 mile existing paved trail that continues to Cedar Hill Road and terminating at Biwood Road.



The goal of the trail system is to establish a bicycle and pedestrian network and to facilitate non-vehicular movement and provide ready access to locations such as parks, schools, the library, neighborhoods, retail centers and business parks for our residents. Listed below you will find the distances from road to road for the 5.24 mile Horsham Powerline Trail:



Blair Mill to Dresher Road	.73 Miles
Dresher Road to Norristown Road	1.39 Miles
Norristown Road to Babylon Road	1.25 Miles
Babylon Road to Limekiln Pike	.75 Miles
Limekiln Pike to Cedar Hill	.89 Miles
Cedar Hill to Biwood Road	.23 Miles

Horsham History

Almost as old as Horsham Township is the Keith House located at 859 County Line Road. Nestled on 42 tranquil acres in the heart of the Township, in Graeme Park, the Keith House's intriguing and colorful past dates back to 1722.

The house was built for the Provincial Governor of Pennsylvania, Sir William Keith as a summer residence. Originally called 'Fountain Low' because of its many natural springs, the property contained not only the large stone mansion but also a 'long house' for servants, a barn, a malt house and several smaller dependencies on more than 1,700 acres.

In 1739 Fountain Low was purchased by Dr. Thomas Graeme, the governor's son-in-law. As a respected doctor, Judge of the Supreme Court, and Port Physician for the city of Philadelphia, Graeme wanted a residence for summer entertaining which reflected his social prominence.

During the Revolutionary War, the property was seized by the colonial government but returned to the Graeme family in 1781. Since then, the property was owned by several different families, finally being donated to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in 1958. The house itself is a National Historic Landmark and has remained virtually intact since the late 18th century with original woodwork and paint finishes in some of the rooms. It is also the only surviving residence of a Colonial Pennsylvania Governor.

Kohler Park Restoration Project

The Plan detailed a “wish list” of projects that included pond dredging with bank stabilization, new restrooms, replacing the playground, installing a new picnic pavilion with electricity, water fountains for the Dog Park and improved paved trail connections.

In 2011, Township Council entered into an agreement with the Horsham Rotary Club accepting the Rotary Club’s contribution of \$75,000 towards a new playground and picnic pavilion, which were recently built and opened to the public. The Township received a second PA-DCNR grant for the new restrooms, to be completed over the winter months. Through Township Councils partnerships with the Horsham Rotary, the State and Toll Brothers, these substantial improvements were accomplished with minimal township expenditures.

Multiple improvements to Kohler Park were secured recently by Council during the land development process for Horsham Valley Estates on Babylon Road (being built by Toll Brothers and contiguous to the park). In addition to securing an additional 10.59 acres of open space for Kohler Park as part of the land development, Toll Brothers agreed to construct the paved connection of the Powerline Trail between Babylon Road and Limekiln Pike, install paved connections from the trail to the dog park and clear/grade an area of land for future recreational use. More importantly, Council continues to work with Toll Brothers to coordinate the renovation of the Kohler Park pond with bank stabilization through installation of a stone wall perimeter. The pond project should be completed by Spring, 2014. With the additional acreage, Kohler Park will be a total of 82.01 acres.

In what was supposed to take 10 years or longer, the Horsham Township Council has been instrumental in accomplishing the Kohler Park Master Site Plan in just three to four years. Councilwoman Deborah Tustin said, “the Kohler Park project is unique in that it involved a degree of cooperation between the Township, the Rotary Club and Toll Brothers. This is the result of good policy, planning and partnerships. This partnership will enhance Kohler Park as well as benefit the residents. It is what the residents expect and like to see happen.” By next Spring, residents will have an opportunity to enjoy yet another progression in the enhancement of Kohler Park, adding to the beauty of Horsham Township’s oldest park.


RAIN GARDEN WORKSHOP

November 6, 2013 at 7:00pm

Horsham Township Community Center

A rain garden is a planted shallow depression designed to catch and filter rainfall runoff. The garden captures rain from a downspout or a driveway. The water sinks into the ground, aided by deep rooted plants that like wet and dry conditions. A residential rain garden should dry out between rains and should only hold water for approximately 24 -72 hours. This timeframe prevents standing water that could create mosquito habitat. BACK TO SCHOOL - BUS SAFETY

- Drive carefully and be alert.
- Stop at least 10 feet away from a stopped school bus with its red lights flashing and stop arm extended.
- Do not move until all of the children have reached a place of safety.

Horsham Police are asking residents to please drive safely when running late and approaching bus stops to drop off children. If your child is late getting to the bus the 10 feet away laws still apply.



HOW READY ARE YOU FOR ANOTHER SUPER STORM SANDY?

Do you remember last October when 80% of the Township was without power due to Super Storm Sandy? It is that time of year again and a good time to re-check your list of things that you need to have ready and be prepared as winter approaches. Residents need to have the tools and plans in place to make it on your own, at least for a period of time, no matter where you are when disaster strikes. Preparing for the unexpected makes sense. FEMA's Ready Campaign asks residents to take the following simple steps to prepare for and respond to potential emergencies, including natural disasters like Super Storm Sandy. All residents should have some basic supplies on hand for at least three days if an emergency occurs.

The following are recommended items to include in a basic emergency supply kit:

- Water, one gallon per person, per day for at least three days
- Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Whistle to signal for help
- Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Can opener (manual) for food
- Unique family needs such as daily prescription medications, infant formula or diapers and important family documents.

Stop by to learn more about how you can help keep Horsham a safe place to live and work. The initiative of this year's Fire Prevention Week is to Prevent Kitchen Fires. Some tips are offered below:

- When you fry, grill or broil food, stay in the kitchen.
- Maintain a kid and pet-free zone at least 3 feet away from stove.
- Turn pot handles away from the stove's edge.
- Keep a lid and oven mitt nearby when you're cooking in case of a grease fire. If you have a grease fire, slide a lid over the pan. Turn off the burner and leave the pan covered until it is completely cool.
