HORSHAM COUNCIL WELCOMES A NEW MEMBER



NO INCREASE IN REAL ESTATE TAXES FOR 12TH STRAIGHT YEAR!!

Despite an increase of \$1 million in this year's budget, Township Council adopted a budget with no tax increase for the 12th consecutive year. Horsham is proud to have one of the lowest real estate tax rates in Montgomery County and the lowest in Eastern Montgomery County.

The real estate tax rate will remain at one mill. The one-mill tax rate means the owner of a home assessed at the township average of \$178,212 will pay \$178.12. That tax bill will be used as follows: \$83.72 for the library, \$55.22 for the Fire Company, and \$39.18 for parks. None of the real estate tax will go for the general operation of the township government. These costs are covered by the earned income tax.



The budget totals \$15.1 million. Some of the major expenditures in the new budget include the purchase of three new police cars, the purchase of new weapons for the police, replacement of 83 streetlights with energy efficient LED lights, milling and paving of the Oak Terrace development, Virginia Lane, and sections of Cedar Hill Road and Park Road, the purchase of a 10-ton dump truck for the Highway Department, renovation of the limestone trails in the park system and a trail behind the Horsham Rd. Firehouse connecting to Kohler Park.

The balanced budget continues to fund the high level of services to the residents, infrastructure maintenance and improvements, and capital expenditures while keeping taxes at their current level.

Police Chief Robert Ruxton Retires & New Chief Sworn In

Horsham Police Department will have a new Chief for the first time in almost two decades. Chief of Police Robert Ruxton retired in January 2014 ending a 41-year career with the Horsham Township Police Department. Chief Ruxton started his career with the Horsham Police Department in March 1973 as a police officer. His promotions within the Department led to positions as Sergeant, Platoon Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain. He was appointed Chief of Police in 1995.

As Chief, he has seen the Horsham Police Department grow to 40 sworn officers and 10 civilian personnel. Under his direction, the Citizens Police Academy and the Chief's Advisory Teams (CHATS) were started, along with Adopt-a-Cop that puts officers in schools to keep in touch with students and teachers. Chief Ruxton also led the effort to computerize the police department.

Chief Ruxton's career is filled with service to Horsham Township but also to fellow police officers around the state. The Horsham Police Department was among the first ten departments in PA history to receive State Accreditation. In 2001, Chief Ruxton was inducted into the Hall of Fame of the International Police Association.

Deputy Chief William Daly was promoted to Chief of Police on January 8, 2014 at the Township Council meeting after Chief Robert Ruxton officially retired. Bill Daly will officially move up from Deputy Chief to Police Chief on January 20, 2014.

Daly, a U.S. Air Force veteran who started his career with the Horsham Police in 1987, rose through the ranks and was named sergeant in 1998 and lieutenant in 2004 before being appointed the department's first Deputy Chief in 2013. Daly is the fourth police chief since the department's inception in the 1950s.

REAL ESTATE TAX BILLS

Real Estate Tax bills for Horsham Township and Montgomery County will be mailed by February 1, 2014. The tax bill provides a portion of the necessary income for the Township to run effectively. Payment is due as follows:

April 30, 2014 - due at 2% discount

June 30, 2014—due at face amount

Tax payments made after June 30th are paid at a 10% penalty. Postmarks within the stated deadlines are accepted; and deadlines that fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, are due on the next business day.


The following are a few things that you can do to help ensure a safe and happy winter for yourself and the Horsham Township Highway Department:

Horsham Township Highway Department oversees the clearing of 105.04 miles of roads in the township. Please try to be patient as we clear the roads.

Once snow accumulates two (2) inches or more and until the roadway is cleared by the Highway Department, no vehicle, trailer, boat or camper may be parked in the roadway.

Keeping sidewalks safe is an important winter concern. Residents must clear snow, sleet and ice from sidewalks in front of their property no later than 24 hours after a storm. For stubborn icy spots, be sure to use environmentally friendly deicing products.

It is impossible for snowplows to avoid having snow placed at the bottom of driveways. A helpful hint is to shovel snow in driveways to the right side of the driveway (as you face the road) and clear the area immediately to the left of your driveway.



The Highway Department works extremely hard to make traveling on Township roads safe for everyone. Please be patient and allow time for them to arrive in your area and effectively remove snow and ice from the streets.

PennDOT clears the following 23.72 miles of state roads in Horsham Township:

- County Line Road
- Easton Road (Route 611)
- Route 309

Recycling containers and trash cans should be placed on the lawn or curb in front of your property.

Remember that it is illegal to shovel, blow or plow the snow from your driveway and/or sidewalk into the street.




If you own a portable basketball hoop that you leave in the street, now is the time to remove it as they create a hazard for the snow removal crews.

Keep the storm water inlet open near your property. Keeping it open will prevent flooding and icing conditions on the street.

FIRE MARSHAL SAFETY TIPS

Fire Hydrants: For your safety, please help the Horsham Fire Company by clearing snow away from fire hydrants in front of your property. Firefighters need approximately three feet in all directions to be free of ice and snow in order to properly connect hoses to a fire hydrant. The few extra minutes you spend clearing snow from your property and from a hydrant can make a big difference during an emergency.



Place Wood Ashes Outside of Home:



To prevent the possibility of fires in a garage or home, residents who have wood burning stoves or fireplaces are asked to store ashes in a metal container that is placed outside and a safe distance from the home.



WINTER STORMWATER TIPS

Winter is here and rain turns to snow, it is important to consider stormwater pollution. Pollutants such as soaps, fertilizers, automotive fluids, and pet waste can collect in the snow pack, accumulating until a thaw suddenly dumps them into the storm water system. Contaminants that end up in the storm drains are carried off, untreated, to streams and larger bodies of water that are used for drinking, swimming, or fishing. Check that your car is not leaking oil or other fluids. It takes only a small amount of motor oil to pollute thousands of gallons of water. Use a car wash to get the winter grime off your car so the water will be treated before being released into the watershed. Don't salt your driveway and sidewalks as salt runs off of your sidewalk and onto the surrounding soil. Consider more environmentally-friendly deicing products.



Horsham History ~ The Penrose Strawbridge House





The Penrose/Strawbridge Farm is a 102-acre property located on the southwest side of County Line Road in Horsham Township and is part of the Horsham Township Park System. It is located next to Graeme Park, the estate of colonial Governor Sir William Keith which is now a state park and museum. The farmstead consists of two houses, a barn, a well and pump house and two smaller outbuildings.

The original structure, is believed to have been built by Governor Keith as part of the estate he called Fountain Low as early as 1721. Keith's Estate passed down to Dr. Thomas Graeme, to his daughter Elizabeth Graeme Fergusson, then to Samuel Penrose and his descendants. It was purchased by Welch and Margaret Strawbridge in 1920. The Penrose's made a great many changes to the property including greatly expanding what we now call the Penrose Strawbridge House.

The Strawbridge's donated the portion of the estate now known as Graeme Park to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in 1957 to guarantee its preservation. When Welch Strawbridge died in 1969, Mrs. Strawbridge took control of the remaining 101-acre farm. In 1982 in an effort to preserve the farm and the surrounding land, Mrs. Strawbridge sold the tract to the National Lands Trust for \$1.00. Part of this agreement of sale included a clause allowing Mrs. Strawbridge to live in the house until her death. Mrs. Strawbridge died in 1996. On January 8, 1997, the 101 acres of the Penrose/Strawbridge farm was sold to Horsham Township by the Natural Lands Trust. The agreement of sale states the property is to be used for open space and will not be used for further development of the Township.

The Strawbridge House is now on the National Register as a Contributing Resource to Keith House.




