# ELECTRONICS COLLECTION INFORMATION

Free collection events are held outdoors from 9am-3pm, rain or shine. Residents may attend any event as well as any Electronics Collection event held by Bucks, Chester, Delaware, or Philadelphia Counties.

Event workers will unload your electronics so please remain in your vehicle.

Electronics are collected for recycling. All computer hard drives will be shredded to ensure data security. **Acceptable items** include TELEVISIONS OF ANY SIZE AND SHAPE including console, tube, projection, flat screen, computers and monitors, laptops, printers (paper removed), scanners, fax machines, keyboards, mice, speakers, copiers, VCRs, DVD players, CD and MP3 players, converter boxes, cable/satellite receivers, telephones and equipment, cell phones, video game consoles, cameras, calculators, stereo and radio equipment, typewriters, microwaves, toasters, irons, blenders, mixers, coffeemakers (no glass carafe), vacuums, other SMALL household appliances, dehumidifiers, air conditioners (window unit or portable, no full size) and mini-refrigerators(no full size).



**Do Not Bring** household hazardous waste, alkaline batteries, video tapes, audio tapes, CDs, light bulbs, explosives, ammunition, smoke detectors, or

**Large Appliances:** these should be taken by your trash hauler or a scrap dealer, a list of which can be found at [iscrapapp.com](http://iscrapapp.com).

**Refrigerators, Freezers, and Large Air Conditioning Units:** these should be taken to a Freon certified handler, locations listed in the Recycling Guide at [MontgomeryCountyRecycles.org](http://MontgomeryCountyRecycles.org).

## Paper Shredding Event Information

Free paper shredding events are held outdoors from 9am-noon, rain or shine, for Montgomery County residents only. Please remove plastic, cardboard, and metal other than paper clips and staples. This residential event is not open to businesses.
