

Township Council Authorizes Review of Township Building

Horsham Township Council has authorized a request for proposals from architectural firms to conduct a feasibility study of the existing municipal building. The study will explore a variety of scenarios to meet the long-term facility needs.

Recently, William Walker, Township Manager gave Council a presentation on the condition and challenges of the existing building. The building was built in three phases with the middle section built in 1959, the east wing built in 1971 and the west wing built in 1989. Each addition was added to meet the Township's growing demands. Before the Police Department moved into their new building in December 2009, 64 full-time and 10 part-time employees worked in the Township Building. With the Police relocated on the complex and Recreation Services now at the Library, there are 14 full-time and two part timers working in the building.



Due to the age of the building there are some major challenges that include a leaking roof, two roof mounted air conditioning units that no longer work, water infiltration into the lower level, deterioration of the building façade and concrete, ADA issues, security issues, old electrical fixtures that bulbs are no longer made for and technology that is not up to current standards. Mr. Walker stated, "The current building has many issues that need to be addressed."

"We need to determine whether it would be more cost effective to just make repairs, renovate the current building or construct a new one. We want to evaluate it and understand the costs," Councilman Gregory Nesbitt said.

Council President Mark McCouch said, "Now is the appropriate time to take a look at this and know our options before we invest in the building. An architect will be hired this fall and the feasibility study will be completed in early 2016. Public input will be sought by Council before they make any decisions on the township building."

SIGN-UP FOR EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS

The Montgomery County Department of Public Safety, along with its emergency management partners in the Southeastern PA region, have changed the company that operates our ReadyNotify alert and notification system.

The new alert system is called ReadyMontco. The types of notifications you can select remain the same as ReadyNotify. In addition to text messages, you'll be able to receive alerts on your smartphone via a mobile application and you'll also be able to prioritize how you receive messages so you don't continue to receive multiple alerts for the same event. In addition, you'll be able to set up quiet times so some of the lesser-important alerts won't interrupt your lifestyle.

When a crisis affects Horsham Township, Emergency Management officials must be able to reach residents instantly with warnings, information, and updates. Be among the first to find out and stay informed during an emergency. Alerts can be sent to your cell and smart phone, pager, and/or e-mail. You decide how you'd like to be notified (these alerts are free; however, your cellular provider may charge for text messaging).

Individuals and businesses are urged to log onto www.readymontco.org and follow to the Montgomery County, PA registration page. It is very important to note on page 4 - My Alerts, that you select My Alerts and check Horsham only (*this guarantees that you will only receive alerts for Horsham Township, not all of Montgomery County*).

Township Council Acquires New Open Space



Horsham Township Council at the new property

On April 30, Horsham Township acquired approximately 6 acres to be added to its 844 acres of municipally owned permanently protected open space.

The site at the intersection of Horsham Road and Dresher Road is impacted with floodplain, steep slopes and established woodlands. In addition, the Pennypack Creek traverses the property. In the past,


the property was a private swim club in the 1950's and more recently used as part of a garden-landscaping supply business.

The Township believes the property is critical to the Pennypack Watershed. Concepts for the preserved area will be to demolish and remove any remaining structure, restore the riparian corridor of Pennypack Creek, conduct a feasibility study for a stormwater control feature, and to provide an aesthetic gateway to our office parks on Dresher Road.

Mr. McCouch, Council President, stated, "Preserving this property shows the Township's continued commitment to protecting the environment and open space as well as try to help the neighborhoods downstream in the watershed".

Maintaining Driveway Culverts

Driveway culverts connect open ditches on either side of a driveway. This allows water to flow under, rather than over, the driveway. The purpose is to maintain the free flow of water and not impede or reduce the water carrying capacity of the culvert or channel. Individual property owners are responsible for the structural integrity and maintenance related to having a pipe culvert under their driveway. Maintenance responsibilities on a pipe culvert or channel running under your driveway consist mainly of keeping it clean. This means free of trash, debris and sediment; clear of overgrowth, choking or clogging vegetation; free of obstructions or structures. Culverts or channels must not be filled in, plugged, blocked, diverted or altered in any way. Do not fill in or pave over open ditches. This helps avoid flooding and helps prevent icy conditions in the roadways when the temperatures are low.



Horsham History

Social gatherings were popular among the early residents of Horsham Township. People came together to share news and

to help with the work. Sewing circles served a utilitarian, as well as social purpose, since all clothing was made by hand. Eight girls formed the "Thimble Club" which met for nearly seventy years during the nineteenth century.

It was customary for young girls to practice the various embroidery stitches on pieces of linen. These were called samplers, because examples of each type of stitch mastered would be included in a design. Sometimes a Psalm or a proverb would be embroidered on the cloth, or perhaps, the letters of the alphabet. The sampler would then be hung on the wall for all to see. Sometimes a girl would give a small square piece of material to each of her friends, and ask that they write their names on the material. Often a child would write a small verse or decorate the square in addition to the signature. Always the best handwriting would be used for the signature. The squares were then collected by the owner of the material, who would then embroider whatever design and name that appeared on the square. Finally the squares were sewn together to make a quilt cover.

In 1867 Elizabeth Walton Mullin made a quilt, now in the possession of her grandniece, Mrs. Helen Stemple Childs, of Doylestown, on which can be found the names of the descendants of the first settlers of Horsham. The following surnames appear on the quilt: Lukens, Slack, Doan, Hallowell, Armitage, Kenny, Watson, Walton, Carr, Iredell, Lewis, Mullin, Kermey, Kirk, Priestley, Dresher, Logan, Kenderdine, and Wilson.



Police Department Reaccredited

Horsham Township Police Department has upheld its status as an "Accredited Law Enforcement Agency" for the fifth term. To reach the level of accreditation, a department must establish policies that cover approximately 140 standards of best policing practices. During a two day assessment, three independent assessors from the Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police Association conducted an extensive review and evaluation of Horsham Police Department's policies and procedures. The process is conducted every three years and verifies that the department continues to meet or exceed the highest professional standards.

The Horsham Township Police Department received accreditation from the Pennsylvania Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission beginning in 2003. Since then, the Police Department has completed a reassessment in 2006, 2009, 2012 and has now maintained their accredited status for another three (3) years. Currently there are only 101 police departments state accredited out of over 1,200 police departments in Pennsylvania.

Special congratulations to Lieutenant John Potts for a job well done. Lieutenant Potts is Horsham Township Police Department's accreditation manager. He leads the efforts for our continued professionalism in Policing. His exceptional work and dedication to the program has been the catalyst for its success.

A Message from the Fire Marshal

Did you know that most residential fire deaths occur between the hours of 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM when most people are asleep? The key message of this year's Fire Prevention Campaign is to install smoke alarms in every bedroom, outside of each sleeping area, and on every level of your home, including the basement.

As fall comes upon us, The Township Fire Marshal would like to remind the residential community of the municipality's ban on open burning of yard waste and debris. A large disposal container is situated in the rear of the Township Community Center, providing our residential community the opportunity to discard their yard waste in a safe and efficient manner. SEASONAL TIPS

for Protecting Our Waterways


It is that time of year again- fall is here! Horsham Township would like to remind you of the importance of preventing stormwater pollution while you make the most of the fall season. Stormwater is formed when rainwater makes its way into storm drains or runs off our properties directly into streams. On its journey to the stream, stormwater can pick up harmful substances that pollute our watershed.

There are many sources of stormwater pollution unique to autumn, and we need your help to control them. The leaves are falling, and their improper disposal poses a threat to our water resources. Leaf litter and any yard waste dumped into a storm water basin or near a waterway can cause harmful nutrient accumulation. Leaves swept into the street can easily enter storm drains and make their way into the nearest creek as well.

Fall is the time for seeding and fertilizing your lawn. If excess fertilizer is applied, however, it cannot be absorbed by the soil and washes away with the rain. If you are working on a landscaping project in your yard this season, bare soil can also run off into streams and cause sediment pollution. All of these problems can be avoided by putting some of our pollution prevention tips into practice:

- Dispose of leaf litter and yard waste in a compost pile and never in the street or stream! You can use yard and leaf waste as mulch or fertilizer for your yard and garden.
- Do not use fertilizers immediately before a rainstorm, and do not apply them in excess. Always follow the directions on the bottle for safe application and disposal whenever you use a chemical product. Reduce outdoor and household chemical use as much as possible.

A little extra caution while you keep up with your fall to-do list can make a big difference for the health of our watershed, and we thank you for cooperating with this effort.

Horsham Police Department's New Bike Patrol Expands Coverage:

The Horsham Township Police Department continues to expand its coverage with the addition of a bicycle patrol unit. The purpose of the Bicycle Patrol Unit is to perform visible patrol duties, community relations, and crime prevention. The Bicycle Patrol places police officers in the community where they are the most available to the general public. Here they can work side by side with the people in our community to reduce crime, prevent loss of property, stop personal injury, and promote a positive image of our department to both adults and children alike. These officers are out of the police cruisers, which gives them more one-on-one contact and communication with the general public. This allows the officers to get better acquainted with the citizens who live in their patrol area, learn the problems that they are faced with, and aid them in finding solutions to these problems. Police Chief William Daly said "Bicycle patrol is part of the department's ongoing community policing efforts."

Benefits of a Bicycle Patrol:

- Bike patrols are cost effective - ten to fifteen bike officers can be fully outfitted for the cost of one patrol car.
- There are large operational cost savings of a bicycle compared to maintenance and fuel cost of a patrol car.
- Bike officers can travel faster and farther than foot officers and they are able to patrol areas unreachable by car.
- Bicycles give officers the "stealth" advantage - because bicycles are silent, officers can ride right up to the scene of a crime before they are noticed.
- Bicycles are a great public relations tool - an officer on a bike is much more approachable than one in a patrol car.
- Departments benefit from decreased health care costs and better officer fitness.
- Officer morale is improved.

Horsham Township Police Department would like to thank the local businesses & residents that have joined in donations to support the new Bike Patrol. The Police Department has no additional costs associated with the expansion. The Horsham Police Department currently has 6 bikes and 10 trained bicycle officers.

Fall Yard Maintenance

In an effort to increase participation in the state mandated recycling of leaf waste, the Township has located a container in the rear parking lot of the Municipal Complex at 1025 Horsham Road.

Leaf waste includes: leaves, garden residue, shrubbery, and tree trimmings, less than 4 ft. long and 4 inches in diameter.

Items not included: grass, stumps, tree trunks or logs.

All leaf waste must be placed in biodegradable bags. The township sells yard waste recycle bags (3 bags for \$1.00) for our residents' convenience.

This service is available to residential property owners only and we will not accept waste from landscapers or non-residential properties. Leaf and yard waste burning in Horsham Township is prohibited.

Bamboo Regulations To Be Enforced in Horsham

Horsham Township Council will be adopting a new ordinance this fall to address bamboo issues. The new ordinance purpose and intent is to preserve and protect private and public property from the damaging spread of certain bamboo grasses, protect indigenous plant materials from the invasive spread of bamboo, and maintain the general welfare of the residents of Horsham Township.

Bamboo, which technically is a giant grass, is one of the world's most invasive plants. Once established, it is literally next to impossible to control. The sprouts that shoot up from the ground each spring can grow 12 inches a day! Bamboo has been known to spread rapidly underground, in some cases, moving to nearby properties, continuing to sprout underneath siding and causing property, as well as home damage.

There's no denying bamboo makes a pretty, exotic screen. And with its slender form, it is seemingly ideal for tight urban spaces. Yet, in no time new shoots will appear outside its planting space, creating a maintenance nightmare.

If Horsham Township receives notice that bamboo is present on a property, a letter with a copy of the ordinance and directions regarding its control will be sent to the land owner. If any residents have questions concerning the new ordinance please call Code Enforcement at 215-643-3131.



NAS-JRB Willow Grove

Horsham Land Redevelopment Authority

The Horsham Land Redevelopment Authority is moving ahead with two critical negotiations with the goal of obtaining the surplus federal property at the former NAS-JRB Willow Grove base. The HLRA is negotiating with the U.S. Navy to determine a fair value for the property and the method to compensate the federal government in returning the land to local control. At the same time, the HLRA is negotiating a Master Developer Agreement with Catellus Development Corporation to develop the 862 acre parcel. Since their selection earlier this year, Catellus has quickly undertaken a thorough review of the property and has retained highly qualified local consultants to assist them in dealing with the many issues related to creating a new mixed use development including a vibrant town center. Catellus is actively seeking new tenants who want to locate their company to Horsham Township and take advantage of the wonderful parks and open space, well regarded school system, and the highly skilled work force.



Horsham Police Department National Night Out 2015






