

HORSHAM TOWNSHIP CONTINUES TO PROACTIVELY TAKE ACTIONS TO ENSURE OUR WATER IS SAFE

We recognize and respect that many Horsham residents are justifiably concerned about the safety of our water supply. Horsham Township and the Horsham Water and Sewer Authority (HWSA) remain committed to ensuring the ongoing safety of our community's water supply. Your health and safety is our utmost priority.

While the water delivered from our system to your home continues to meet or exceed all EPA and DEP standards, we have undertaken a number of actions since the EPA announced its new Lifetime Health Advisory of perfluorochemicals (PFCs) levels of 70 parts per trillion.

- In early July, after Township Council reviewed multiple options, we finalized an aggressive \$1.2 million short term remediation plan to address the unacceptable levels of PFCs found in Horsham's water supply. Township Council elected to implement a remediation plan expected to bring average PFC concentration levels in the Township's water system to less than one parts per trillion (ppt). by the end of 2016 – a water quality standard that will far exceed any other known published standard in the nation. Under the plan, the HWSA, with the support of the Township, installed custom filters on the five public wells that previously exceeded the EPA's PFC levels, which allowed them to be put back into service. The U.S. Navy has committed to paying for the filters. And we are committed to having the plan fully in place by December 31, 2016.

- In July, Horsham Township Council and HWSA arranged for independent third-party testing of tap water in a representative sampling of over 100 homes across all neighborhoods in the township. The additional testing was conducted proactively by Horsham Township to further demonstrate the safety of public water. The results will be available in the Fall and shared publicly with all of our residents. Results are expected to show that PFC levels in resident tap water will be well below the EPA Lifetime Health Advisory.

Drinking water article continued.

- On July 25, Horsham Township bypassed its regular land development process and expedited construction of new permanent water treatment facilities for two public wells. The Navy is paying for the construction.
- In partnership with our elected officials, U.S. Representatives Brendan Boyle and Patrick Meehan, we hosted a health expert panel discussion on water quality in Horsham Township on August 29 at Hatboro-Horsham High School. Representatives from the EPA, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), DEP, the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry participated in the panel, provided information to residents of Horsham, Warminster and Warrington townships - along with former military personnel and employees stationed at the Willow Grove and Johnsville naval air stations - and addressed many of our concerns and questions regarding the safety of our water supply.

Our progress could not have happened this quickly without the partnership and leadership of many of our other elected officials as well. We thank State Representative Todd Stephens and State Senator Stewart Greenleaf for their diligence in advocating on behalf of all of us and ensuring that those responsible for the contamination of our water pay for the remediation initiatives. A state grant appropriating \$10 million in critical infrastructure funding to Horsham Township to remove contaminants in the public water supply (including added filtration systems to our public wells) was shepherded through the state legislature by Representative Stephens over the summer.

Wes Frees' store

Shown to the left, is Wes Frees' store front with a small platform that was the Hallowell Trolley Station. The store and station were located at the corner of Meetinghouse and Easton Roads. Local farmers placed their milk cans on the platform by 7:30 am each day. The trolley came along shortly thereafter and took the milk to be sold in Philadelphia. Each can was marked with a label showing the name of the owner, and the next day, the cans were returned to the same platform.

The picture on the right is the Friends Meetinghouse (1913) which is located on one of the other corners and you can see the trolley tracks in the foreground of this photo.



We seek to implement this vision through our **FREE SMOKE ALARM** program which offers a free smoke alarm to any resident in Horsham who is in need. The only prerequisites are that they reside in the home and have a genuine need for our assistance.

You may also request a **FREE HOME HAZARD ASSESSMENT**. The assessment will be performed by the Firefighters after installing the free smoke alarm.

Free smoke alarms are available for pick up at the Horsham Township Building in the Code Department on the lower level of the building or the Horsham Fire Company.

K-9's On Duty

Horsham Township Council welcomes the two newest members of the Police Department during the National Night Out celebration: Banner (a German Shepard) and Gallant (a Dutch Shepard). Horsham Council approved its first ever K-9 unit in January. Almost immediately local businesses and residents showed their support with a variety of donations. Chief William Daly stated "The support from Horsham Council and the Horsham Community has been overwhelming."

After weeks of training Officer Kate Ryan and Officer Andrew D'Arcy recently returned with their new partners from a facility in North Carolina. The canines will be living in the homes of the officers while off duty. During working hours, the K-9s will be scheduled on opposite rotations to ensure a canine will be covering every shift. Banner and Gallant will participate in community relations programs such as school visits, civic group meetings, and other local events for demonstrations.

A MESSAGE FROM THE HORSHAM FIRE COMPANY



Horsham Fire Company # 1 is a combination fire department providing Fire, Rescue and EMS Protection to the residents and business owners of Horsham Township. In addition to 35 volunteers there are 5 full-time firefighter/paramedics and one full-time Firefighter/EMT. There are

also 25 part-time firefighters, EMT's and paramedics that routinely cover shifts to assure adequate coverage around the clock.

From January 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 the fire company responded to over 300 fire calls and 950 EMS calls. The annual call volume over the past few years has been in the area of 650 fire calls for service and just under 2000 EMS calls.

The Horsham Fire Company responds to calls out of two stations. The Meetinghouse Road station is located next to the Lukoil station at Meetinghouse Road and Easton Road, it houses both ambulances, an Engine, Ladder, Quint (Ladder truck with a pump), and the Rescue truck. The Horsham Road station is located next to the township building and directly across from Deep Meadow Park, it houses one engine, one utility truck, and a hazmat trailer.

In January, the Fire Company signed a contract with VCI/Horton to re-chassis one of the ambulances. It is expected to be returned in late August. It is the first time Horsham Fire Company has done this! In early July, our Quint was certified by the County and the Pa Dept. of Health as an Advanced Life Support (ALS) responder. This allows the Fire Company to respond with paramedics to EMS calls while either returning from another emergency or in times of high call volume, as a third unit.

In anticipation of the Horsham Township's 300th anniversary, the Horsham Fire Company # 1 stands ready to support the celebratory events. If you see any member of the Fire Company at these events or anywhere else, please do not hesitate to stop by and ask any questions you may have about the Fire Company. Also, Tours are provided of the firehouse and/or our trucks when available.

The HLRA is continuing to monitor the efforts by the Navy and the PA Air National Guard to address the groundwater contamination recently discovered on the military property and in the adjoining neighborhoods. The Navy must certify to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) that the federal surplus property is suitable to be transferred to the local community before any transfer can occur. The HLRA staff is actively participating in meetings, conference calls and briefings and is reviewing the environmental documentation provided by the Navy and the PA Air National Guard.

EMERALD ASH BORER



A very destructive wood-boring beetle which attacks Ash trees has already killed millions of ash trees throughout the United States. The beetle was first discovered in Michigan in 2002, in 2007 the beetle reached western Pennsylvania, then in 2012, Southeastern Pennsylvania. Surrounding areas including Horsham have many Ash trees located on public and private property that have clearly been effected by the Emerald Ash Borer.

The beetle attacks the cambium layer of the tree and is difficult to detect in the early stages, and can go unnoticed for up to 3 years. The beetle lays eggs in the grooves of the trees bark, the larvae stage is what causes the damage in the cambium layer and the adult beetle emerges from the tree to begin the process again on another tree

Symptoms include: branch dieback in the upper crown of the tree, excessive epicormic (small branch growth/suckers) branching on the tree trunks vertical bark split. Other signs are "D" shaped holes in the tree where the beetle exits the bark and usually woodpecker damage in their attempt to eat the larvae and beetle. Unfortunately by the time you can see the symptoms it could be too late to effectively treat the tree.

Maintaining Driveway Culverts

Driveway culverts connect open ditches on either side of a driveway. This allows water to flow under, rather than over, the driveway. The purpose is to maintain the free flow of water and not impede or reduce the water carrying capacity of the culvert or channel. Individual property owners are responsible for the structural integrity and maintenance related to having a pipe culvert under their driveway. Maintenance responsibilities on a pipe culvert or channel running under your driveway consist mainly of keeping it clean. This means free of trash, debris and sediment; clear of overgrowth, choking or clogging vegetation; free of obstructions or structures. Culverts or channels must not be filled in, plugged, blocked, diverted or altered in any way. Do not fill in or pave over open ditches. This helps avoid flooding and helps prevent icy conditions in the roadways when the temperatures are low.



FORECAST FOR HORSHAM'S FINANCIAL FUTURE IS SECURE

HORSHAM STRONG

Horsham Council is pleased to announce that Moody's Investors Service has recently upgraded the Township's General Obligation bond rating to Aa1 from Aa2. Moody's confirms the upgrade to Aa1 reflects the Township's strong financial reserve trend, its' very low debt profile, its' large tax base and average wealth indicators. The bond rating is a reflection of the Township's credit worthiness, and considered by some a fiscal report card of the Township's finances and policies. In a very practical sense, the upgrade would serve to save the Township on any borrowings, as bond ratings are a contributor of determining interest rates paid by municipal governments.



REFINANCE OF THE HORSHAM TOWNSHIP LIBRARY

With the advice of Public Funds Management, Inc., an advisor to Council and Horsham Township on its municipal borrowings, Horsham Council recently named the financing team for the Township and authorized them to proceed with efforts toward the proposed refinance of the approximate \$5.375 million bond issue which supported the Horsham Library. The refinance and restructure of the bond has been undertaken given long-term interest rates remain well below historic averages. Refinancing and restructuring of the bond is expected to extend the maturity of the bond by an additional 10 years. The refinance is expected to provide a long-term cost savings to the Township and to help preserve the rainy day fund of the Library. On average, it is estimated that the annual debt service on the bond will be reduced by nearly \$100,000.00 per year through 2032.

HORSHAM TOWNSHIP LIBRARIAN RETIRES



After a number of residents expressed their desire to have a township library, Horsham Council approved to move forward with a feasibility study and request for proposals in 1999. Years

before the Library was established Ms. Laurie Tynan volunteered many hours to Horsham Township researching the logistics of establishing a Library while working as the full time Library Director at the Montgomery County Library. When Horsham Council approved moving forward with the architects design of the 25,000 square foot Library Ms. Tynan came on board as Horsham's first full time librarian. She started working diligently finding a wide variety of literature for everyone to enjoy! After months of establishing the library's selections she called out to the residents of Horsham to organize and place over 65,000 books on the shelves. Quickly residents were volunteering to be a part of the "Book Brigade". In less than a week the library was completed and ready for the grand opening in October 2004. Ms. Tynan has successfully run Horsham Township's Library for over a decade achieving many awards and growing the Library into a well known gathering place for all residents to enjoy. Councilman William Whiteside stated "On behalf of Horsham Township Council we thank Ms. Laurie Tynan for her dedication to the Horsham Library and wish her the best in retirement." Enjoy the fall colors but be sure to keep leaves out of the street

If you listen carefully, you may soon be able to hear the first golden aspen leaf quiver, quake and fall to the ground. Not too long after that, you'll look out the window one day to find your entire yard covered in a patchwork mosaic of yellow, orange and red leaves and you'll wonder, "Where has the summer gone?"

Beautiful as the fall leaves are, they mean lots of yard work for local homeowners. One option for reducing your workload is to use a mulching lawn mower to mulch leaves into your yard. It is less time intensive than raking and the shredded leaves act as a natural fertilizer during the fall.

While you are tending to your yard, take a moment to sweep or rake leaves and branches out of the street in front of your house. Left in the street, they can clog storm drains, contributing to localized flooding. When washed into nearby lakes, rivers and streams via storm drains or ditches, the leaves become a major source of phosphorus, the nutrient that allows algae to bloom in the summer. Dispose of leaves by composting them in your yard, bringing them to Horsham Township recycling container or bagging them for curbside pick-up by your selected municipal waste hauler. Keep leaves and yard waste out of the regular garbage, and never dump them in wetlands or buffer areas.



Fall Yard Maintenance

In an effort to increase participation in the state mandated recycling of leaf waste, the Township has located a container in the rear parking lot of the Municipal Complex at 1025 Horsham Road.

Leaf waste includes: leaves, garden residue, shrubbery, and tree trimmings, less than 4 ft. long and 4 inches in diameter..

Items not included: grass, stumps, tree trunks or logs. All leaf waste must be placed in biodegradable bags.

In January, 2016, Horsham Council approved the Horsham Business Parks Master Plan intended to encourage in the coming years, the redevelopment and updating of the Pennsylvania Business Campus and the Horsham Business Center. These business parks occupy 615 acres and serve as an employment center for over 15,000 jobs in the Township. The Master Plan set out a vision for updating the parks to a more vibrant, sustainable and walkable modern model. As part of the recommendations of the Master Plan, it recommended that the Township create a new staff position that would coordinate and facilitate economic development efforts on behalf of the Township.

In addition to his role in coordinating and facilitating redevelopment efforts in the business parks, serving as a primary resource and liaison for Horsham Business and general economic development efforts in the Township, Larry will also support the Township's interests in redevelopment efforts at the former NAS-JRB Willow Grove Naval Base.




Witmer Road Connection Trail OPEN!
