## ITEMS BEING COLLECTED

### **MOBILE DEVICES**

*CELL PHONES, MP3 PLAYERS, IPODS, TABLETS, LAPTOPS*

### **ACCESSORIES**

*EARPHONES, CHARGERS, CORDS*

### **SMALL ELECTRONICS**

*CALCULATORS, CAMERAS, CAMCORDERS, PDAS, RADAR DETECTORS, GAMING SYSTEM CONSOLES, GPS UNITS*

### **INK JET CARTRIDGES**

*Recycling electronics not only reduces landfill space, but also keeps substances like mercury and lead, hazardous elements found in most electronic devices, from entering our air and waterways.*

According to the Pennsylvania Covered Device Recycling Act of 2013, it is illegal to throw most electronic items in the trash.
