President Tustin opened the public hearing at 7:58 P.M. in the Township Building, 1025 Horsham Road, Horsham, PA.

President Tustin opened the hearing on the Liquor License Transfer application as submitted by 575 Horsham Liquor Owner LLC (Horsham Corner Shopping Center at Horsham Road and Norristown Road) to transfer a license to Horsham Township.

Mr. Walker provided an overview of the application for the inter-municipal transfer of a Liquor License to 575 Horsham Liquor Owner LLC which will be located at 575 Horsham Road.

President Tustin opened the discussion of the application at which time Mr. Edward A. Taraskus, Esquire, Law Offices of Edward A. Taraskus, P.C., spoke on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Alex Henry, of Korman Communities, also spoke on the application.

Discussion regarding the application included but was not limited to who the liquor license was for, the hours of the operation, types of beverages, if there would be music, if there would be outside seating, take out service and if the sketch plan was accurate for the layout.

The Applicant asked to continue the hearing to a later date when they would be able to answer council's questions and be able to tell council who is going to be the owner of the license.

Mr. Taraskus stated that he would send a letter to the Township waving compliance with the statutory forty-five day period for a hearing and decision.

Mr. McCouch made a motion to continue the hearing to a later date, Mr. Nesbitt seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

President Tustin adjourned the Hearing on the liquor license transfer application at 8:05 P.M.
