Vice President Mr. McCouch opened the Council meeting with a Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 PM in the Township Building, 1025 Horsham Road, Horsham, PA. Mr. McCouch asked for questions or comments from the public. Ms. Katherine Joyce, 48 Buckman Drive inquired how tonight's meeting was advertised. Mr. Walker explained it was on the Township TV channel, website, Facebook, Twitter and emailed to all those that have subscribed at water@horsham.org
