

On Thursday, March 12, 2020, Governor Tom Wolf announced [significant action on COVID-19 which closes all Montgomery County Schools and many facilities for a 14-day period beginning on Friday, March 13.](#)

Today, Friday, March 13, 2020, Horsham Township Council has authorized a Declaration of a Disaster Emergency in response to the COVID-19 emergency.

The Horsham Township Municipal Building and Police Department remain open. We are asking that residents limit requests for non-essential services over the next 14 days. When possible, we ask that you consider contacting the Township or Police Department via email at [horsham@horsham.org](mailto:horsham@horsham.org) and [police@horsham.org](mailto:police@horsham.org) or call (215) 643-3131 for the Township and (215) 643-8284 for Police non-emergency instead of visiting the buildings.

The Park and Recreation Board meeting on March 17, 2020 and the Township Council meeting scheduled for March 23, 2020 have been canceled. Additionally, the U.S. Navy Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting on March 18, 2020 has been canceled.

The Horsham Township Library and the Horsham Township Community Center are closed and will reopen on Monday, March 30, 2020. During this time no fines will be assessed, and library items currently out will be automatically renewed. While we will be emptying our book return, we urge residents to keep your materials at home and not come out unnecessarily during this time. All Library and Recreation programming has been cancelled until March 30, 2020. Those who registered to participate in classes or events will be contacted in the coming weeks about rescheduling or obtaining a refund or credit. The remaining three dates of our Winter Farmers Market (March 15, 22 & 29) have been cancelled.

The Township is in contact with the Youth Sport Organizations and parents should expect notification from the sport organizations concerning upcoming practices, games, and events.
