Horsham Day Restaurant Row Information

“**Restaurant Row**” is located in the Deep Meadow Park Community Village. Deep Meadow Park is located at 1020 Horsham Road, across the street from the Horsham Township Municipal Complex.

As a “**Restaurant Row**” participant, your one 10’ x 10’ tent, two 6’ tables, and two chairs are included and will be set up for you outside of the dining tent. Your assigned “double” space will be waiting for you to set up. Please note that this space can accommodate two 10’ x 10’ tents, one of which is provided. If you are cooking over a flame, you will need to bring your own fire extinguisher. A refrigeration truck will be available for your use, compliments of *Bova Foods*. Do not forget to bring large enough plates to handle your food items, plenty of business cards, your raffle items, giveaways, tape, scissors, and anything else that you might need to set up your table. Please watch the weather forecast for the day and dress accordingly. Restroom facilities are available in Deep Meadow Park.

You may begin to set up your display as early as 8 am. **All passenger vehicles must be out of Deep Meadow Park by 10:30 am** so, please allow enough time to set up your display. Your packet contains two parking passes; one permits vendor parking in the Horsham Township Municipal Complex on a “first come, first serve” basis. The other is for your foodservice delivery vehicle parking at Deep Meadow Park. If there is no room at the Municipal Complex, or if you have multiple passenger vehicles, please park at Hatboro-Horsham High School located at 899 Horsham Road. Transportation will be available to Deep Meadow Park; alternatively, you can carpool or walk. For your convenience, parking passes will be delivered to your restaurant. Vehicles parked in the Horsham Township Municipal Complex without a parking pass are subject to towing at the owner’s expense.

Our restaurant participants have three departure times: 5:00 pm, 7:30 pm, and after the fireworks or about 10 pm. We encourage you to stay through the dinner hour, which is the 7:30 pm departure. If you depart at either 7:30 pm or after the fireworks, your transportation vehicle will be escorted out of the parking lot by Horsham Township.
